Accommodation, food, transport and all programs and excursions will be included into the package. Just organise your flight to Australia and leave the rest to us.

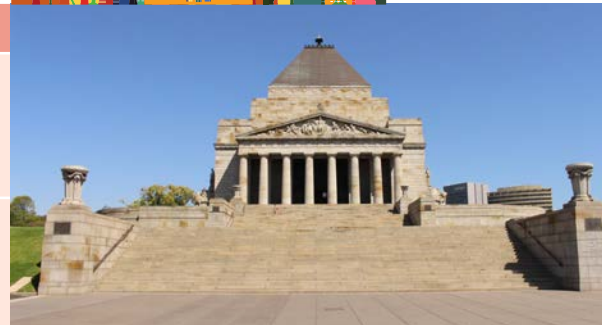
STUDY TOURS

Days	Morning	Afternoon
Monday	English Class 1: Learn greetings, common everyday expressions in Australia and learn about key parts of Melbourne that we will be using on tour.	Melbourne Tour - Our immersive experience includes learning about shopping centres, train stations, markets and some tourist attractions.
Tuesday	English Class 2: Lesson focuses on animals and nature understanding more about Kangaroo's, Koala's and other Australian animals. We explore their natural habitats, diets and behaviour.	Melbourne Tour - National Gallery of Victoria, Royal Botanic Garden, Shrine of Remembrance
Wednesday	English Class 3: Intercultural communication. The ways of communication between people from different cultures could be different.
